Faulty equipment	Bruises, cuts and abrasions	Group	Medium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All equipment should be checked by the Instructor prior to and during the session. 	Low
Faulty Electrical Equipment	Electrocution	Group/ Instructor	Medium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Equipment to be checked prior to use in accordance with training given. Faulty equipment should be reported immediately and taken out of use. 	Low
Electrical Wires	Injuries caused by tripping, e.g. Sprains, cuts, bruises	Group/ Instructor	Medium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ensure all hanging or trailing leads/wires are securely covered or taped down. 	Low
Hard, uneven and slippery surfaces	Slips, trips and falls	Group/ Instructor	Medium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Area checked for hazards before session. Group checked to ensure they are wearing suitable footwear. 	Low
Heat	Risk of dehydration	Group/ Instructor	Medium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Room should be ventilated as necessary. Water should be available for participants. 	Low
Collisions with other participants during the activity	Concussion, bruises or abrasions	Group/ Instructor	Medium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Instructors to ensure there is good group control during the session. 	Low
Collisions with activity equipment/ furniture	Bruises, cuts & abrasion	Group	Medium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any equipment / furniture not in use should be removed from the activity area. 	Low
